Accommodation

The venue is situated at Woorim on Bribie Island. It is less than one hundred metres from a white sandy beach, where dolphins are seen. Walking tracks are nearby, accessible by foot or short drive. The centre surrounds provide natural reflective space too. This centre offers ensuite cabins which can take between 4 to 8 persons. At this retreat we will aim to limit rooms to four unless a larger group number is requested, or registration numbers increase. This would require some using bunk beds. Numbers are therefore limited, so plan to register early. All accommodation and session resources are included in the cost.
